IORK 2025 Heats and Final Process

Qualifying Heats

- Each driver will compete in 6 qualifying heats, with 16 drivers per heat.
- Qualifying heats will follow the IORK format with drivers racing for position.
- Compulsory Pit Stops: In each qualifying heat, every driver must complete 2 compulsory stop/go pit stops before the race ends.

Finals Qualification Process

Categories with Fewer than 32 Drivers:

• The top 16 drivers based on points from the qualifying heats will go straight to the Grand Final. (no semi finals will be held)

Categories with 33-40 Drivers:

- The top 10 drivers based on points from the qualifying heats will go straight to the Grand Final.
- The next 16 drivers will compete in a 15-minute semi-final.
- The top 6 finishing drivers from the semi-final will join the 10 pre-qualified drivers in the Grand Final.

Categories with 41 or more Drivers:

- The top 32 drivers based on points from the qualifying heats will advance to the semi-finals, which will consist of two 15-minute semi-final races, each with 16 drivers.
- The top 8 finishing drivers from each semi-final will advance to the Grand Final.

Semi-Finals

- Points No Longer Count: Once drivers reach the semi-final stage, points from previous heats are discarded. Race results are based solely on the finishing positions.
- Compulsory Pit Stops: Drivers must complete 2 compulsory timed pit stops during the 12-minute semi-final race.

Grand Final

- The top 16 drivers from the qualifying heats and semi-finals will compete in the Grand Final, which will be a 45-minute race.
- Compulsory Pit Stops: During the Grand Final, each driver must complete 4 compulsory timed pit stops before the race ends.
- The Grand Final is decided purely on overall position, with no points carried over from earlier stages.
